1. Summary of Placement Statistics AY'2021-2022

The St. Claret College Training and Placement Centre experienced a parabolic rise in placements while maintaining the quality and adhering to the vision and mission of the college to provide a holistic education and assistance to the community of students. 100 recruiters visited St. Claret College for recruitment from Corporates and Top MNC's of, IT/ITES, Finance, Accounts, US consulting, Production, Manufacturing Industries, Travel and Tourism, Hospitality Managements Industries, Risk Management Industries etc.


