
Objectives:

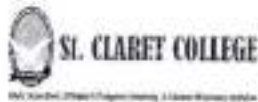

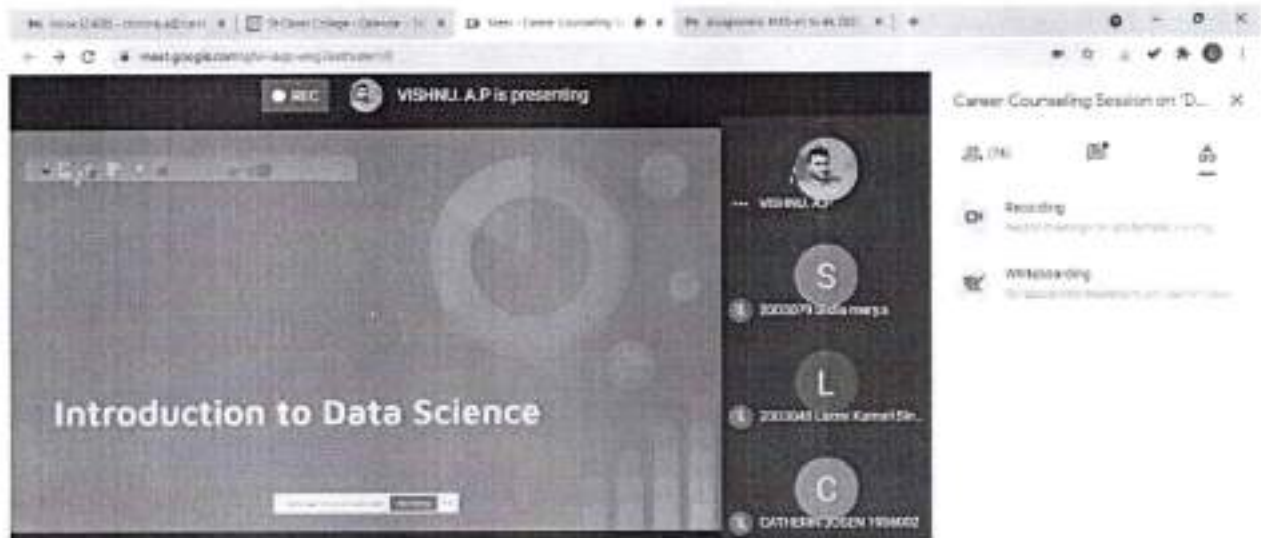
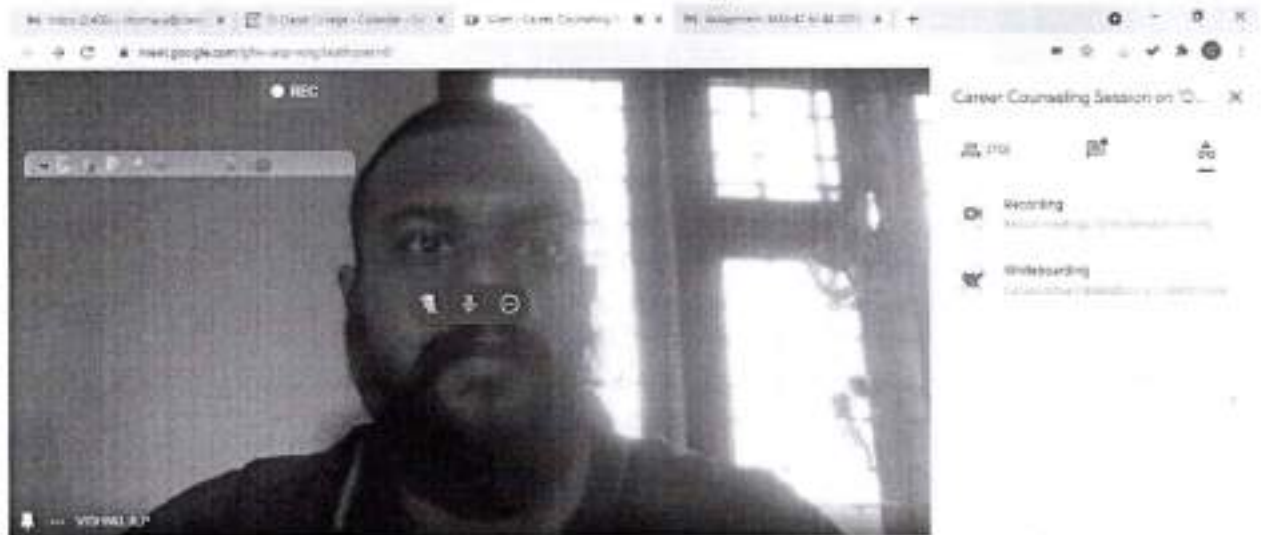

- To create an awareness among the student about the various types of Soft skills required for better employability.

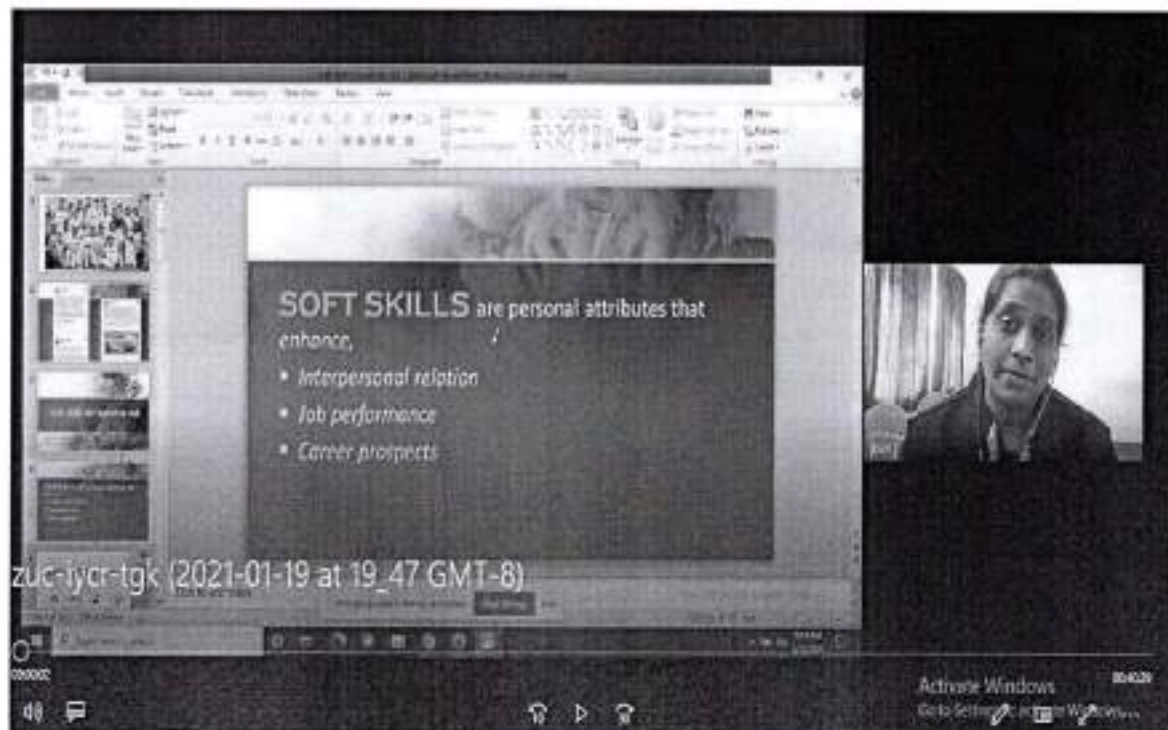
Programme Highlights

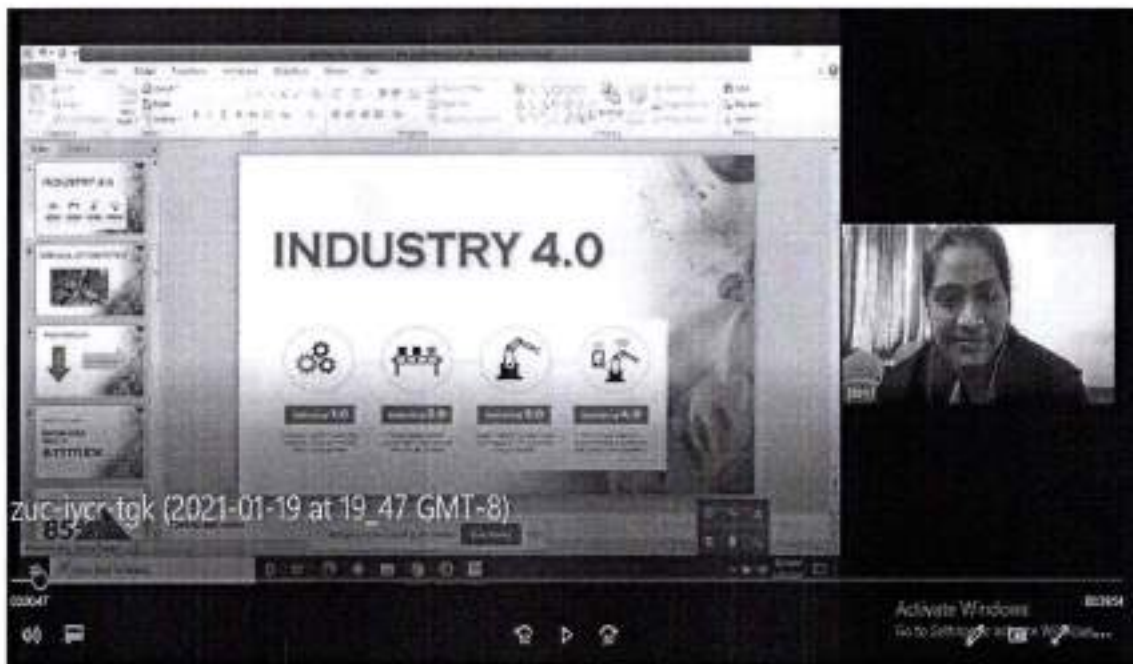

- E1 – Emotional Intelligence

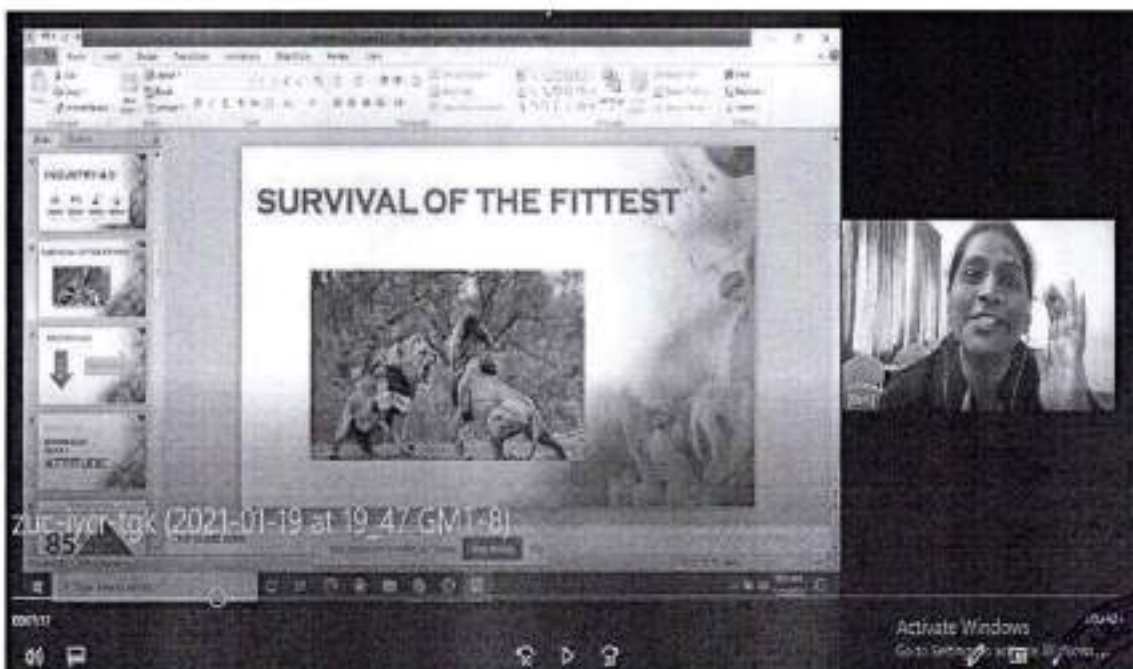


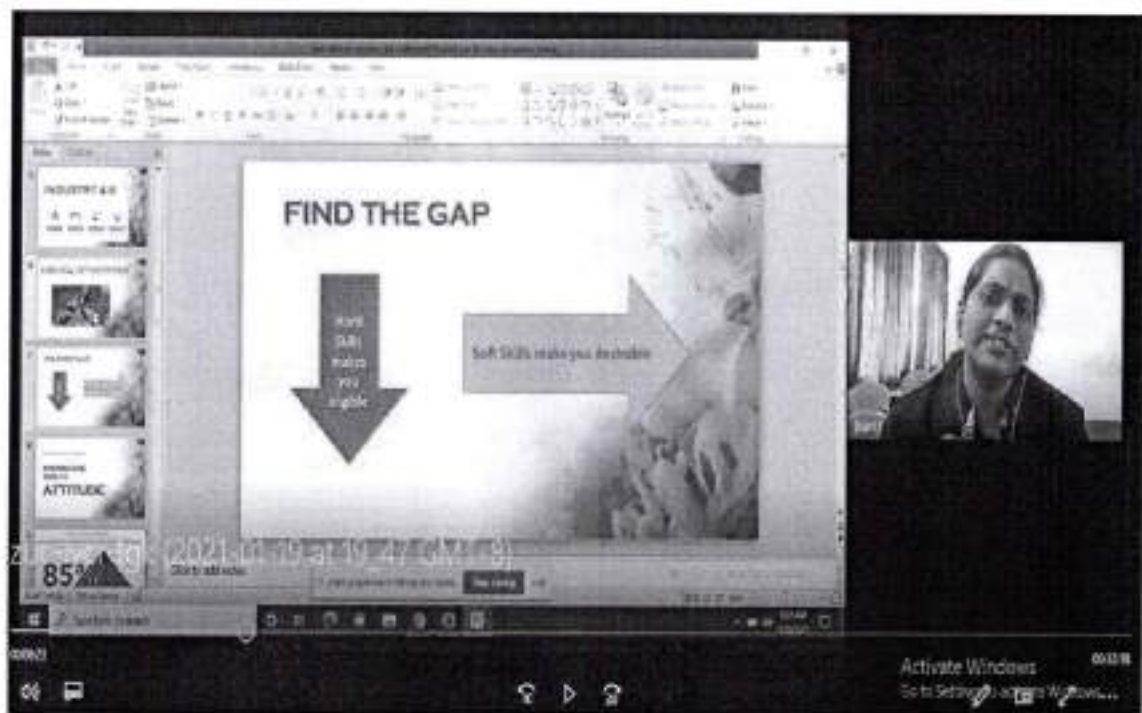
