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It is hereby notified that, the procedures to be followed for collection of examination fees for I Sem (Repeaters), III and V Sem (Freshers & Repeaters) BA /BSc B.Com / BBA / BBM / BBA (Aviation Management) / BCA /BVA /BSW /B.Voc(IT) / B.Voc(RM)/B.Voc(FP&N) / B.Sc(H.Sc) / B.Com(HONS) / B.Sc(IDD) / B.Sc (Forensic Science) /BASLP I Sem Repeaters, III, V & VII semester BHM etc., examination and filling of examination application forms are as detailed below. The Officers / Officials of Examination Section of BU and Principals and their staff of affiliated colleges have to follow the procedures laid down scrupulously as was done during previous examinations.

- The Principal of all Affiliated UG Colleges have to Use the password issued to them during previous examination for downloading the examination fee collection pro-forma of March/April-2022 Examination from the website <a href="www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in">www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in</a> By using the password the college can access the format of examination on the screen, course wise and semester wise. The colleges have to enter all the details required in the pro-forma of each candidate in the format. After entering the details of all the candidates, such as course/semester, subject appearing, category and fee, the colleges can download the filled pro-forma of each candidate. The colleges have to collect the fees as per the fees notified hereunder from the candidates.
- 2. The college have to download individual application form after filling all particulars in the system itself and submit the same along with necessary documents. The colleges have to take the photo of the candidate through web camera is not available or if there is no facility to scan the photos, such colleges have to down load the filled application form and collect the photos from the candidate and paste in the space provided on the downloaded application form.

## 3. PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF EXAMINATION FORMS AND PAYMENT OF EXAMINATION FEE:

- a. The Bangalore University has introduced collection of examination fees through online for the UG courses.
- b. The principals have to collect the exam fees as per the schedule shown above.
- c. The principal should obtain the on-line for examination fees collected immediately on the next day of the last date fixed for the collection of examination fees.
- d. Principal have to use the same PASSWORD issued previous years for accessing exam application form, and new colleges have to obtain the password by submitting an application along with affiliation order and Mobile number of the Principal.
- e. University will host the list of candidates of 1st Semester Repeaters and 3rd, 5th & 7th Semester Freshers and Repeaters (in BHM) course Wise/semester wise with Register number on the website <a href="https://www.bangalore.ac.in">www.bangalore.ac.in</a>
- f. After entering the password, the Principal will get the course wise list of 1st Semester Repeaters 3rd, 5th and 7th semester Freshers & Repeaters (in BHM) candidates. Under course wise list, the list of candidates with Register number will be displayed on the screen.
- g. When the Register number of the candidate is entered on the system, his application form will be displayed on the screen with all the subjects of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester Repeaters 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> semester Freshers & Repeaters (in BHM) course.
- h. Colleges have to tick on the subject for which the candidates is appearing for the examination. If any subject is not displayed, the colleges have to enter the subject and tick on the subject in the column provided in the system.
- If any candidates (Fresher or Repeater) information is not found on the website, then there is a provision on the website for the Principal to add the details of the left out candidates.
- j. After ticking on all the subjects, the computer automatically displays the total amount of examination fees to be paid by the candidate.



k. Thereafter, the Principal may take out print outs of the student copy, college copy and the university copy. After taking the print out, the colleges have to verify the fees printed in the downloaded examination application with the fees notified in the examination fees, Collect the examination fees from the candidates and issue the student copy with the seal and signature of the Principal to them.

l. On the last day of the notified date, the system will get automatically locked and the colleges can take print out of the total number of candidates, total amount to be paid course wise and semester wise. On that basis the colleges have to obtain Examination Fee On-line. Fees & submit the same to be Account section at Pareeksha Bhavan, Jnanabharathi Campus along with three sets of downloaded candidate list to issue examination admission ticket and nominal rolls.

m. For extension of any dates in payment, the same procedure has to be followed with

fine on the notified dates mentioned in the fee extension notification.

n. Principals shall ensure that, only those students who have fulfilled the attendance requirement as laid down in the regulation of the course, shall be allowed to fill in the examination application and only such students shall be permitted to appear for examination.

Note: College offering Courses Having practical/Viva-Voce/Project/Dissertation Examination shall contact the respective BOE Chairpersons well in advance for conduct of the said examination.

5. Information Regarding Scholarship (FEE CONCESSION FROM THE GOVT):

a. The Principal of the college are not supposed to demand the prescribed examination fees from SC/ST students of Karnataka (ಸರ್ಕಾರದ ಆದೇಶ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ: ಸಕಾಇ–83/ಪ.ಕಾಬಿ. 2012, ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು ದಿನಾಂಕ: 27.06.2013). The fees prescribed to be paid by them will be reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department on Submission of On-line Post Metric application by the SC/ST students.

The Principal should ascertain that the SC/ST student have submitted the following photocopies of the document (attested by the Gazetted Officer) along with online Post-Metric Application (on which the photo of the student and 17 digit Registration Number is displayed):-

1. Caste Certificate of the student issued by the Tahsildar.

- 2. Parents Annual Income Certificate (less than or equal to Rs.2.5 laks) issued by the Tahsildar. (Valid up to 5years) (If the parent of the student is a state/Central Government Employee, Salary slip shall be insisted along with the income Certificate).
- 3. Previous year Marks card / Result sheet.

However the SC/ST Students whose fees are reimbursed form the social welfare Department shall pay only the OMR sheet fee of Rs.15/- each for Theory Practical and Viva-Voca/Project/Dissertation.

The Principal of the college shall obtain the reimbursement of fees by forwarding the online post-metric application to the social welfare department. The fees will be remitted to principal's account DIRECTLY by cash Transfer from the social welfare department. If the fee so remitted to principal's account is disbursed to the concerned students, the concerned principal shall collect the prescribed fees of this semester along with the fees of previous semester form such SC/ST students and remit the same to the University account without fail.

### b. THE FOLLOWING SC/ST CANDIDATES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO CLAIM FEE REIMBURSEMENT

- 1. SC/ST student from other states.
- 2. SC/ST students of Karnataka whose parent's annual income is more than 2.5lakhs.
- c. However if the above documents are not found to be enclosed along with the online post-metric application, the principals shall collect the full prescribed fee from the SC/ST students. The fee reimbursement is not applicable for repeaters who belong to SC/ST of Karnataka. Hence, the principals shall collect the prescribed fees from the repeaters and SC/ST students of other states and remit the same to the University account.
- d. In case of non-receipt of Scholarship/Fee reimbursement of a particular student from the Social Welfare Department for the reasons mentioned there in by the Social Welfare Department, the Principal shall collect the prescribed fee of this semester along with fee of previous semester and remit the same to the University account without fail.
- e. As per Govt. Order No:ಹಿಬಿಸಿಜೆ/589/ಬಿಎಂಎಸ್/2013, ದಿನಾಂಕ 5–10–2013 ಮತ್ತು 06–08–2014, The Tuition, Laboratory, Examination, Library and sports fee (The amount of Fees prescribed by the University or the maximum limit of fees fixed by the BCWD WHICHEVER IS LESS) OF THE Cat-1, 2A, 3A & 3B and other students will be reimbursed to the concerned College Bank Account, for the students who are eligible for admission to the said course and year, subject to the condition that the Annual Income limit which is Reflected in the Government Order (Cat-1 students whose Parent's annual Income is less than or equal to Rs. 1.0 Lakhs are eligible to apply for the reimbursement of Fees).

- f. The candidates belonging to minorities (i.e, Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Sikhs, Anglo Indians, Jains etc.,) whose parent's annual Income is less than or equal to Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakshs only) are eligible to apply for incentive of Rs. 4,000/- from Minorities Welfare Department (MWD) as per the norms of MWD (ಸರ್ಕಾರದಆದೇಶ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ: MWD 21/MDS2011 dated: 02-08-2014).
- g. The principals of the Colleges shall collect the prescribed examination fees from the Cat-1, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B and other students. The prescribed fee shall also be collected from SC/ST students whose parents' annual Income is more than are 2.5 lakhs.
- h. The Principals of the Colleges should give undertaking to the effect that they would get the re-imbursement of Examination fees of students and remit them to the University.
- 6. The mere payment of examination fee and submission of applications does not entail the student to appear for the examination, unless he/she fulfils all the conditions of the course laid down in the regulation of the course by the University.
- The Practical examinations time-table for the course wherever prescribed will be notified by the Chief-Superintendent of the concerned examination centre. The practical examination should be conducted before theory examination.
- 8. After the completion of all the practical examinations, the practical ML (Marks List) sheets receive from examiner in sealed cover subject/paper wise, semester wise, course wise, should be submitted to the Office of the Registrar (Evaluation), Pareeksha Bhavana, Jnana Bharathi Campus. Bengaluru-560056. on or before 3 (Three) working days after complete of practical examinations.
- 9. The Internal Assessment/Grading (as applicable) shall be submitted through before 11.02.2022 to the on or University website www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in Using the same Pass Word given previous year, and also hard copy of the Internal Assessment /Grading (as applicable) should also be submitted on or before 11.02.2022 to the Registrar (Evaluation) Pareeksha Bhavana, Jnana Bharathi, Bangalore-560056. IA received after the last date will not be accepted. Therefore, he Principals are requested to pay their personal attention and ensure that IA marks/ grades are correctly submitted before the last date positively to avoid any inconvenience to the students. The Principal of the respective college will be personally held responsible for non-submission of IA marks/Grades. Failure on the part of the Principal in this regard will be viewed seriously and the matter will be reported to the commissioner, Higher Education and the Principal Secretary, Higher Education for further action.
- Late submission of examination applications and online if any, to the University by the colleges will attract penal fee of Rs, 5,000/-.



- Question paper Indent Pro-forma will be hosted on University web site www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in. during the Second week of 11.02.2022 the same should be downloaded and fill the same. Filled question paper indent (Hard Copy only) along with one set of candidate list (for verification & return) should be submitted to the Office of the Registrar (Evaluation), Confidential Section, Pareeksha Bhavana, Inana Bharathi Campus, Bangalore -560056 on before 15.02.2022 failing which Rs. 5,000/- will be imposed as penal fee for late
- 12. As per regulation governing UG courses, a candidate should complete his/her degree course within Five Academic Years from the date of admission to the First Semester. (ACA I/UGC-Guidelines/Span Period/17-18 dated 13.07.2017 Circular). Register No. 17 & onwards are eligible to appear for March/April-2022 Examination. However, BHM course Register No. 16 and onwards are eligible to appear for March/April-2022 Examinations.
