

IPR Week - IPR Workshop On "Impact of IPR"






National Level Online Student Workshop on "ENTREPRENEURSHIP"


Three Day Student Entrepreneurship Bootcamp

Intra-Collegiate Business Plan Competition




Workshop on Workshop "Start-Up Ideation"
