Guidelines for Paper Submission

- 1. Each paper must cater to one specific sub-theme of the conference or anything closely connected to the theme / sub-theme.
- 2. The paper submitted can be either empirical or conceptual.
- 3. The abstract should be submitted in MS Word format and should be not more than 250 words. The document must mention the title of the paper, name of the first and second author along with their affiliations.
- 4. The full paper should be submitted in MS Word format and the word limit for the full paper is 3000 words including references.
- 5. Use Times New Roman 12-point font, 1.5 spacing and the paper must be in APA 7 format.
- Submitted papers must NOT have been previously presented, scheduled for presentation, published, or accepted for publication by any other source (journal, publisher or any other organisation)
- 7. NO changes in the paper title, abstract, authorship, nor submitted document shall be permitted AFTER the submission deadline.
- 8. Time limit for paper presentation is 8+2 minutes.
- 9. As regards the acceptance of paper, the decision of the conference team will be final.
