 - 5) Who is Timothy?
 - 6) What is inferred from the usage of the term *scarlet soldiers* in *O What is That Sound*?
 - 7) Who were the passengers in the carriage in *Because I could not Stop for Death*?
 - 8) Why has the narrator stopped by the woods in the poem *Stopping by Woods* On a Snowy Evening.
 - 9) What does the theme in the poem Enterprise revolve around?

 - 1) Why does Yutang regard the discovery of one's favourite author as the most critical event in one's intellectual development?
 - 2) What rules does Orwell cite for relying on when in doubt about the use of a word or a phrase or when instinct fails while writing in English?
 - 3) Give a character sketch of Alfred Nobel.
 - 4) What are the varied reactions to Rachel Carson's Silent Spring?
 - 5) Narrate how Timothy became the member of the family.
 - 6) Describe the coming of the soldiers in the poem O What is That Sound.
 - 7) In the poem *Because I could not Stop for Death*, why do you think there is reference made to delicate clothing the narrator is attired in? Give reasons for your observation.
 - 8) How does Frost make us realise that it is necessary to stop by and appreciate beauty in his poem *Stopping by Woods On a Snowy Evening*?
 - 9) Describe the difficulties faced by the travellers in Ezekiel's Enterprise.

- 5) Give an account of Carson's life.

- 7) How does Robert Frost's *Stopping By Woods On A Snowy Evening* bring out the contrast between the two worlds?
- 8) Elucidate on the use of various symbols in *Enterprise* which makes us refer to it as a symbolic poem.
