Round 1: Preliminary Round Case Study on Justice

Objective:

Participants will analyse and present solutions for a real-life case study focused on the value of Justice.

Eligibility:

Team should consist of 2 members only.

Rules and Regulations

- The case study for the preliminary round will be provided on 16/10/2024 (Wednesday).
- The case study will be based on real-life events or hypothetical situations related to justice.
- Teams must submit their solution in written/typed format (PDF) on or before 18/10/2024 5:00 PM (Friday).
- Font Style Times New Roman, Font Size 12 and the document should be saved with the name of any one member, class and section. (Eg: Kagendra_III BSc A)
- The submission should include background analysis, key issues identified, proposed solutions and justification for the proposed solutions.
- Word limit: 500-1000 words.

Final Round: Debate Competition on Justice

Objective:

Teams will engage in a formal debate on a topic related to the value of Justice. The topics will revolve around fairness, human rights, equality and legal systems.

Rules and Regulations

Eligibility:

• Only teams that qualify from the preliminary round will participate.

Debate Format:

- The debate will follow the Oxford Style (For vs. Against format).
- Each team will be assigned either For or Against the motion.
- The topic will be provided 3 hours prior to the debate.

Structure

- Opening Statement: Each team has 1 minute to present their opening statement.
- Rebuttal: Each team has I minute to rebut the opposing team's arguments.
- Open Floor Discussion: Teams will engage in a back-and-forth discussion for 7 minutes.
- Closing Statements: Each team will have I minute for their closing remarks.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Content: Strength and relevance of arguments, supporting evidence and data.
- Understanding of Justice: How well the team connects their arguments to the core value of
 justice.
- Rebuttal: The ability to counter the opposing team's arguments effectively.
- Public Speaking Skills: Clarity, persuasiveness, body language and confidence.
- Teamwork: How well the team works together to present a cohesive argument.

Time Management:

• Strict adherence to the time limit is mandatory. Teams exceeding the time limit will be disqualified.

Etiquette:

Participants are expected to maintain respect for opposing teams and the judges. Any form
of disrespect or interruption will lead to negative scoring or disqualification.

The judges' decision will be final and binding.
